Over the past years, our community has been blessed by UMES and Univ of DE not having to increase their rental fees. Unfortunately, the economy has finally caught us and the weekend rental rates that we pay have been increased. Your Board has diligently been working to manage our weekend expenses (a minimal National fee, supplies, clergy service scholarships and incidental food) so that we "break even". That means that the Community does not make any money nor lose any. We have been successful with the collected weekend fees plus your generous offerings.

However, in order to break even in the future, our rates will be increased for the fall 2011 weekends. We understand that the weekend cost to an individual sponsor is becoming a hardship, so the Board is continuing to look at the most prudent way to implement the increase. Getting a co-sponsor or setting up a special fund at your church may be needed to continue to send pilgrims on the Emmaus journey.

God is indeed working in our community. The recent girl's and boy's Chrysalis flights and both our men's and women's weekends were nominally "sold-out"! Continue to pray for our community and for those whose hearts are being called to a future weekend.
